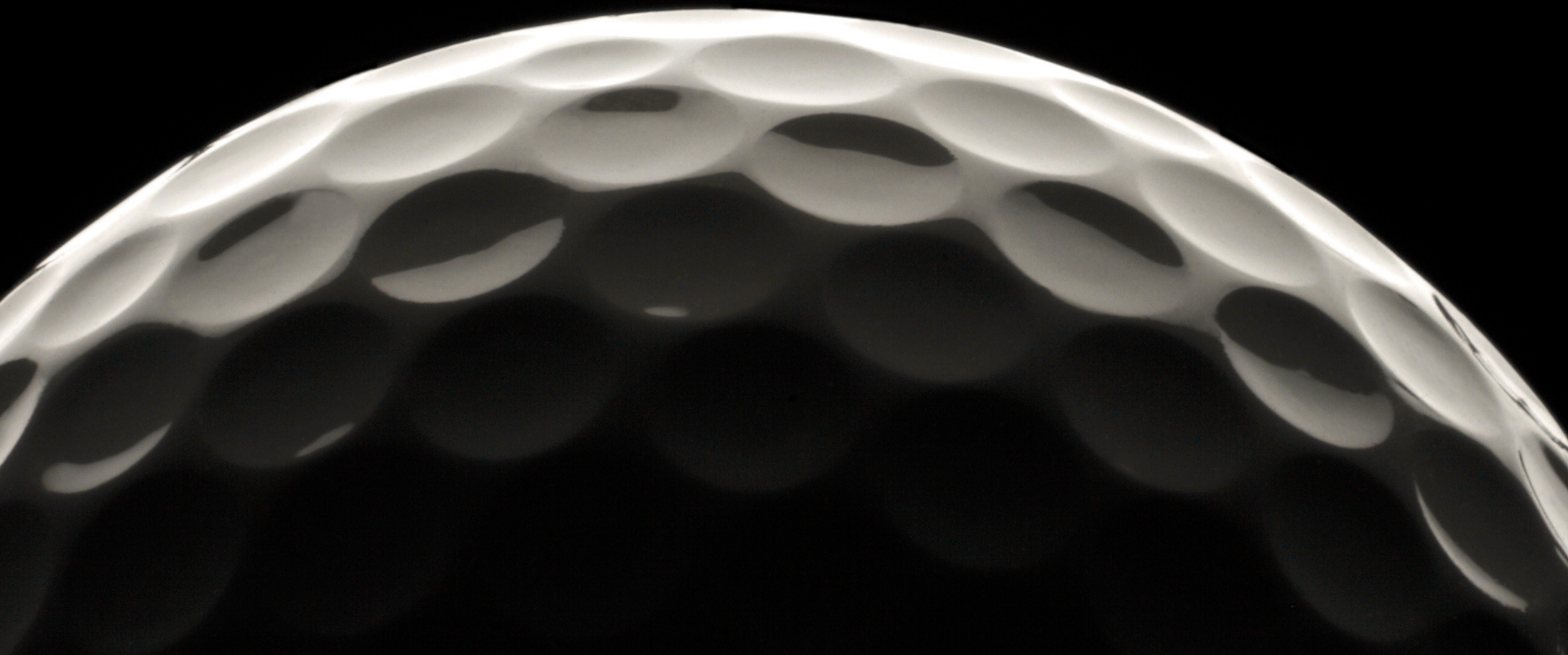

It is estimated that a child is raped or sexually abused every 1,7 minutes in South Africa. Matla A Bana – A Voice Against Child Abuse is an award-winning South African non-profit organisation working to protect children affected by abuse and violence. In partnership with the South African Police Service (SAPS), the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA), government departments and communities, the projects of Matla A Bana reach more than 30 000 children a year.
